## **RICHARD W. SKIDMORE SCHOLARSHIP FUND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AWARD**

### **HISTORY**

The Richard W. Skidmore Scholarship Fund was established on November 1, 1994 by Wayne and Maxine Skidmore in memory of their son, Richard, former Director of Education of City College.

### **BASIS FOR SELECTION**

A student in the *Diploma* program will be eligible after completion of two quarters.

A student in the *Degree* program will be eligible after completion of three quarters.

A student does not have to demonstrate financial need, but must be a current student in good standing.

A student will not be selected on the basis of race, color, creed or gender. The selection process is handled by the Scholarship Board and proposed recipient's name will be referred to the Board of Governors for final approval.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

An application for a scholarship may be picked up in the Financial Aid Office at City College. The applying student must submit a narrative of a minimum of 100 words as to why he/she feels he/she qualifies for the scholarship. The student's narrative must be accompanied by a recommendation from a City College faculty member.

### **CONDITIONS**

Certain conditions must be met. An applying student must have a CGPA of 2.0, must have good attendance, must participate in class discussions and also be involved in community affairs.

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE**

The application deadline is March 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and the scholarship will be awarded in the Spring Quarter of each year.

### **NUMBER OF ANNUAL AWARDS**

There will be one or two **\$500** awards annually, based on funding available.

### **SCHOLARSHIP BOARD**

The Scholarship Board consists of five members. They make recommendation to the Board of Directors for final approval.
