Addendum to Nursing Policies: Program Teach out for the Miami and Fort Lauderdale Campuses

City College had decided to teach out the Nursing Programs at the Fort Lauderdale and Miami campuses. The Fort Lauderdale campus ceased enrolling students in January 2015 and the Miami campus will start a Nursing cohort in the winter 2016 term and will then cease enrollment within the Nursing Program.

All students will be notified by January 30, 2016 of the College's decision to cease enrollment in the program. All students will be planned to ensure that they will be able to take ALL program courses to meet graduation requirements and NCLEX licensure. All Nursing students will be able to take advantage of all resources offered by the College.

The decision to discontinue enrollment and a teach-out, however, will create some changes to current City College policy that will be applicable to nursing students on both campuses effective January 30, 2016.

A list of courses being offered each term until the teach out will be available for all students.

Leave of Absences

It is typically the policy of the College to allow students one leave of absence within a year. The teach out of the Nursing program, however, means that students **may not** be granted a leave of absence because they may miss courses that will not be offered again. If a leave of absence will mean that a student will be unable to take the required courses upon return because they are no longer being offered, the student's request for an LOA will be denied. If the student chooses to not attend campus during that term, that decision will be treated as a withdrawal from the program.

Course Withdrawals and Failures

A roster of course offerings until the teach out is complete will be made available for students. Each student will be advised when courses will be offered. If a student fails or withdraws from a course, there is no guarantee that the course will be offered again (if that is not indicated on the roster). As such, students must take greater care to ensure that their attendance, course participation and grades are of such that they are able to maintain the required B in order to be successful in courses.

Three-Strike Rule

The City College Three Strike rule allowing students to repeat a course is ONLY applicable within the "teach out" period if that course is available for the student to repeat. If that course is not available for the student to repeat, that decision will be treated as a withdrawal from the program.

Re-starts (Miami Campus ONLY)

Nursing Students who have previously withdrawn from the Miami campus may only re-start if they are able to start in a cohort and then move forward. Students who need to take classes which are no longer available are not eligible to re-start in the program.

Transfers

Effective Spring 2016 no students may transfer into the nursing program.
