

Notification of ABHES Program-Specific Warnings as of 10/1/2021

Under ABHES *Chapter III, Section C, Subsection 4* of the *Accreditation Manual*:

City College - Altamonte Springs, FL

The Allied Health, Medical Office Administration with a Concentration in Billing and Coding – Associate of Science program has been placed on program-specific warning status by ABHES. The institution has decided to teach out the program as the campus has been unable to maintain a 70% annual placement rate.

City College - Fort Lauderdale, FL

The Emergency Medical Services – Associate of Science program has been placed on program-specific warning status by ABHES. The institution must submit a teach-out plan as the campus has been unable to maintain a 70% annual credentialing rate.

City College - Gainesville, FL

The Emergency Medical Services – Associate of Science program has been placed on program-specific warning status by ABHES. The institution must submit a teach-out plan as the campus has been unable to maintain a 70% annual retention rate.

The Allied Health, Medical Assisting – Associate of Science program has been placed on program-specific warning status by ABHES. The institution must submit a teach-out plan as the campus has been unable to maintain a 70% annual retention rate.

City College - Hollywood, FL

The Cardiovascular Sonography – Associate of Science program is currently in teach out. ABHES' grant of accreditation for this program expires September 15, 2022, allowing all students currently enrolled to complete the program.

The Emergency Medical Services – Associate of Science program is currently in teach out. ABHES' grant of accreditation for this program expires March 15, 2022, allowing all students currently enrolled to complete the program.

City College - Miami, FL

The Emergency Medical Services – Associate of Science program has been placed on program-specific warning status by ABHES. The institution is required to submit a teach-out plan because to date the campus has been unable to maintain a 70% annual retention and credentialing rates.

Students Enrolled in Programs Listed Above:

All City College student services are available to all current students and all services will continue to be available until graduation.

It is important to note that because enrollment has been ceased, students must take the courses offered as prescribed. If a student fails and/or withdraws from a course, there will be no ability to repeat or take the course again and this will conclude the student's enrollment with City College.
